



Dear Parent/Guardian

9th Penwortham Scout Group runs a 100 club to help to raise additional funds to support the maintenance of our Scout Hut and replace essential equipment.

As a Group we strive to keep the subs that we charge each term to a minimum, and we continue to be one of the lowest charging groups in South Ribble. Whilst the subs that we charge are used to cover the day to day running of the Group, the cost of maintaining our building and replacing equipment continues to rise. We do need to supplement our income to enable us to continue offering the valuable experience that Scouting offers to the young people in our area. It is for this reason that we have set up a 100 club and we would like to ask for your support with this.

The membership to the 100 club is not limited to parents/guardians of the children only. We would love to see wider family members (e.g. grandparents) or just friends of the family supporting us. However, all participants must be over 16. *Please feel free to make further copies/request further copies of the application form for wider family members.*

Each 100 club number costs £2 each month (£24 for the year). The numbers are allocated by the group.

Our preferred method of payment is a £2 Standing Order made payable for the 15th day of each month. The details are **Lloyds Bank Sort Code 30 96 85 Account No 36752168**

Alternatively, payments can be made by cheque (payable to 9th Penwortham Scout Group) or cash directly to the group treasurer **Mrs Kate Haworth, 9 Buller Avenue, Penwortham, PR1 9QQ**. This can be paid either £12 for 6 months or £24 for 12 months.

The draws for the 100 club take place within the last week of each month, the draws take place at a section meeting. This is rotated amongst the different sections.

The principle is that 60% of the money collected goes into the '9th Pen' maintenance fund, the remaining 40% is paid out as a monthly prize. The size of the prize is decided by the number of members that we have at that time.

The results of each month's draw are advertised on the Scout notice board and are also posted on Facebook. Prizes are paid by cheque directly to the home address of the winners.

100 Club Terms and Conditions

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds for the maintenance of the scout hut and essential equipment. The money will be paid into the scout group bank account and used to meet the maintenance costs of the scout hut, providing a valuable service to the young people of our local community.

RULES

- For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
- A draw will be made every month with 1 prize.
- The monthly prize will total 40% of the monthly income.
- The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, guardians, wider family and friends of 9th Penwortham Scout Group.
- Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- Payments should preferably be made by standing order (on the 15th of each month) or annual/6 monthly cheque or cash.
- One month's notice is required for cancellation.
- Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- The draw shall be made during the last week of each month at a section night (this will rotate around the difference sections). Should this fall during the school holidays the draw will take place at the latest possible section meeting within the month. Note: As there are no meetings at all during the month of August, the draw will take place on the first Monday in September.
- The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
- The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the scout notice board and on our Facebook page.
- The 100 Club will be run by the Scout Group Fund Raising Committee. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
- Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Scout Group funds after six months.
- The 100 club accounts will be audited along with the Scout Group Accounts at the end of each financial year.
